Specific objectives

Objective : Test and experiment new techniques for the remediation of degraded and polluted port areas.

How : PMM and its partners have implemented actions aimed at facilitating the identification of innovative solutions and coordinating the implementation of pilot projects.

- Identification of innovative solutions and development of a catalogue to reference these solutions;
- Organisation of matchmaking event between Port Authorities (testers) and solution providers;
- Organisation of workshops (pitch sessions, port site visits);
- Monitoring and coordination of testing actions in partner ports.





Catalogue of innovative solution

Objective : Support port authorities in the access to innovative solutions enhancing the environmental quality of their ports.

How : The project has launched a Call of Interest in September 2024, calling all solution providers developing technologies aiming to improve the environmental quality of port areas.


