INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS LISTED IN THE CATALOGUE IN LINE WITH OUR CHALLENGES

1. Geopolymers, a solution presented by AQUA, immobilize contaminants through absorption, preventing their release into the marine ecosystem.
2. **MARINEROB** that develop an immediate, real-time monitoring of the port environment. It offers continuous analysis of water quality in the port's internal water, external anchorage areas and nearby coastal zone;
3. Autonomous robot offered by **Seabots**, that measure psycho-chemical parameters of water in real time.
